Launch of new Innovation Centre (transition from existing Crumlin site)



Case Study

Global product launch enabled through collaboration

- Global Marketing team successfully won programme
- Designed at Senior Flexonics Innovation Centre
- Manufactured in Europe, North America & South Africa

EGR tubing programme launch for major truck OEM

Product: Heavy Duty EGR Tubes

Requirement: European & North American production

Volume: c.120,000 pa (peak forecast) / SOP 2026

Responsibility: Design, Testing & Development, Project Management & Commercials

Manufacturing: Olomouc, Cape Town, Saltillo

Annual revenue: c.€20m at peak (forecast)







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Case Study

Cross-divisional Collaboration

- Both divisions working on a hydrogen propulsion system project to provide thermal management system
- Flexonics' thermal management knowledge transferable to Aerospace
- Aerospace division providing support to Flexonics division on aerospace qualification
- Manufacturing will be at Flexonics site

Hydrogen Aerospace Innovation

Application: Hydrogen Fuel Cell Propulsion System


Product: Heat exchanger and tube & hose system

Requirement: Retro fit of Dash 8-300 aircraft

Responsibility: Thermal Management System

Funding: £3.8m approved over 4 years

Test flight planned 2029

Designed & Produced in Senior Innovation Centre




